

Annual Student Pass Enrollment Form

Youth in grades 7 to 12 ride CityBus fare-free with the Annual Student Pass. Passes are available to youth in grades 7 to 12, and to adult learners age 21 or under who are enrolled in a primary or secondary education program. Only one pass will be issued per student. Proof of enrollment in school is required to obtain and use the Annual Student Pass. (Proof of enrollment can be a school-issued photo I.D., current report card or school progress report, or letter from the school or adult learning program. Parents of youth schooling at home can obtain a pass for their child by appearing in person at CityBus.)

To obtain your pass:

1. Complete the information below.
2. Review the rules for riding.
3. Bring the form and proof of school enrollment to CityBus (1250 Canal Rd.)
4. There is an administration fee to obtain the pass, see below.

READ CAREFULLY: By signing below, I acknowledge that I have read and understood CityBus's "System Rules" and agree to abide by them while on the bus. I will follow all instructions from bus operators. I understand that the bus pass remains property of CityBus. I acknowledge that the bus pass and the privilege to ride free can be taken from me if I fail to follow the rules. I understand that the bus pass is for use only by me and that it is not transferable to any other person; I will not share the pass with another person. I understand that I may be required by a CityBus driver to provide proof of school enrollment or proof of age, and I agree to provide such evidence if requested. I understand that if I fail to provide such evidence I may be required to pay a fare. If I am unable to pay fare I understand that I may be denied service. Replacement Policy: If the pass is lost or stolen I will notify CityBus immediately so that the pass can be "bad-listed," which means that it will no longer be accepted for valid fare. A replacement pass will be issued by CityBus according to the terms shown below: The first pass is replaced with a \$1.00 administration fee. The second is replaced with a \$25.00 administration fee, and the third pass, if lost or stolen, will not be replaced. I understand that I must provide current proof of school enrollment to obtain replacement passes.

Follow the rules to ride free.

Riding the bus for free is a privilege given only to those youth who *respect* others and themselves by following the rules. Help create a safe, enjoyable ride for everyone. Follow these rules:

- Fare is required from all passengers, except youth. Youth in Grades 7-12 must swipe an “Annual Student Pass” in the farebox to ride free. Proof of school enrollment is necessary to obtain and use the bus pass.
- Children age 5 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- **Fare evasion (not paying a fare, lying about your age, using somebody else’s bus pass or identification, etc.) is a crime. You can lose your privilege to ride the bus, or be arrested and prosecuted.**
- Smoking, food, drinks are not permitted on the bus.
- **Do not use profanity, loud or abusive language. Be respectful and courteous to other passengers and CityBus employees.**
- Follow all instructions given by the bus operator.
- No loitering is allowed on the bus or at CityBus facilities.
- Reserve the front seats for passengers with mobility impairments.
- Move carts and strollers to the back of the bus so that the aisle remains clear. Children must be removed from strollers.
- Exit through the rear door whenever possible.
