## Be prepared for winter weather with CityBus

**Lafayette, Ind.:** While winter has been fairly mild, temperatures are expected to enter the sub-freezing range for the next several days. When extreme weather hits, CityBus is prepared. Learn how you can ready yourself for frigid temperatures riding CityBus.

The CityBus Center will be open extended hours to accommodate passengers waiting for transfers on Wednesday, Jan. 30 and Thursday, Jan. 31 from 7 am until 11:45 pm.

Due to the cancellation of Purdue University classes, the following campus loop service schedules are in effect for Wednesday, Jan. 30:

- 13 Silver Loop: 3 buses operating at 5-8 minute headways
- 15 Tower Acres: 2 buses operating at 8-12 minute headways
- 17 Ross Ade: 1 bus operating at 18-20 minute headways
- 20 AvTech: **NO SERVICE**
- 27 Outer Loop: 1 bus operating at 20 minute headways

14 Black Loop and 28 Gold Loop will operate their normal schedules for the day. City routes, apartment shuttles, and ACCESS service will operate normal schedules.

Any additional changes in service will be shared on the Rider Alerts page on the CityBus website, CityBus Facebook and Twitter pages, and through the MyCityBus mobile app.

Riders can prepare by knowing where to find alerts or subscribing to a CityBus alert tool. Changes in service, notices about delays and alerts about severe weather are all communicated via:

Riders can sign up for email, text and push notifications by creating an account on the MyCityBus app and opting in to notification services. Carrier rates may apply. Subscribers can opt out at any time.

Riders can also contact the customer service office to learn about detours and delays at 765-742-7433 from 7 am to 8:45 pm Monday through Friday and 10 am to 5:45 pm on weekends.

Those who choose to venture out into the cold should take precautions, including wearing weather-appropriate clothing and covering all exposed skin. Know your bus location before you go outdoors and avoid standing in the cold by using one of our real-time bus locator options, which can be found at [www.gocitybus.com/wheres-the-bus](http://www.gocitybus.com/wheres-the-bus).

Take CityBus to your destinations and don't worry about driving on ice or snow.
