### CityBus recognized for alternative fuel efforts

**Lafayette, Ind.:** CityBus received an award from the Greater Indiana Clean Cities Coalition for its efforts in converting from traditional fuel sources such as diesel to hybrid-electric diesel and compressed natural gas (CNG).

The award, which recognized CityBus as the Public Transit Clean Air Champion for 2019, was presented at the annual Coalition Awards and Networking Reception at Oliver Winery in Bloomington. The distinction comes five years after the completion of a CNG fueling station and delivery of twelve fixed route CNG-powered transit buses. Since then, the agency has acquired an additional sixteen fixed route and five paratransit CNG vehicles.

In an effort to reduce fuel and capital costs, CityBus plans to convert its entire fleet of buses to CNG within the next ten years. The agency is currently ahead of schedule, with up to five new buses set to arrive by the end of 2019.

The Greater Indiana Clean Cities Coalition is a leader in the advancement of energy efficient technologies and acts as a resource for 76 counties in the areas of alternative fuels, technologies, and efficiency measures.
